Mārtialis amīcō iūcundissimō dicit haec facere vītās nostrās beātiōrēs: corpus sānum, sapientia, amīcī vērī, somnus facilis. Catullus Lesbiae carmen scripsit in quō inquit: “Vīvāmus atque amēmus, ut nunc habeāmus vītam quam fēlīcissimam; ubi lūx nostra brevissima dēlēta est, ūna nox perpetua nōbīs dormienda est.” In tertio locō Isidōrus dē nōminibus diērum narrāvit; dīxit Rōmānos septem diēs ā stēllīs in caelō appellāvisse: sōl est clārior quam lūna, et Rōmānī, igitur, pīmum diem appellāvērunt “diem sōlis” et secundum “diem lūnae.” Librōs hōrum scriptōrum hodiē legimus ut plūs dē rēbus Rōmānīs sciāmus.
