Create a children's book that teaches the numbers 1-10 in Latin, the corresponding Roman numerals, and the Latin names of common animals.

Requirements:

I. Cover

- Name of the book: Quot Animalia? (1 point)
- Cover illustration (3 points)
- Your name (1 point)

II. Each Page

- Put the Roman numeral at the top of the page. (1 point)
- Below the roman numeral, put the number and the name of the animal in Latin with the translation underneath. ****Make sure you demonstrate the correct use of singular/plural noun forms and adjective/noun agreement.**** (2 points)
- At the bottom of the page, write a grammatically correct sentence in Latin about the animal(s) and then translate your sentence. *****Your book must contain 5 present tense verbs, 5 imperfect tense verbs, 5 adjectives, and 3 prepositional phrases*****(4 points)
- Draw a picture in the middle of the page which illustrates the sentence. ****You may use clipart or cut pictures from a magazine. The illustration must be in color.**** (2 points)

III. Presentation (5 points)
