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quid video? What do I see? (part of speech, morphology) ergō quid habeō? Therefore what do I have? (syntactic function)

ergo quid exspecto? Therefore what do l expect? (morpho-syntactic expectations)

How to use this card to learn to read in word order:

Only expose one word at a time in the window at the top left, keeping the rest of the sentence covered. As you read each word, consider the above questions. Beginners can use this basic placeholding sentence to metaphrase as each new word is met:

Someone/something verbed someone/something (to someone). ACCUSATIVE NOMINATIVE VERB DATIVE

mercator - The merchant verbed something to someone. mercator feminae - The merchant verbed something to the woman. mercator feminae stolas - The merchant verbed dresses to the woman. mercator feminae stolas ostendit. - The merchant showed dresses to the woman.

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
